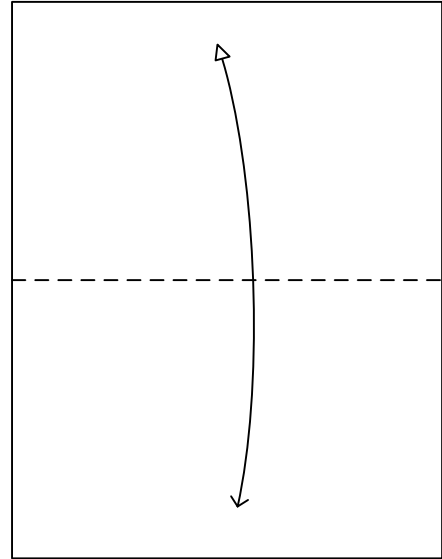
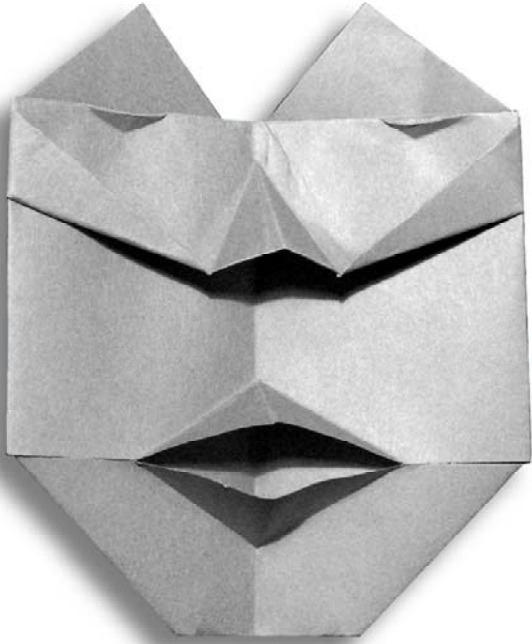
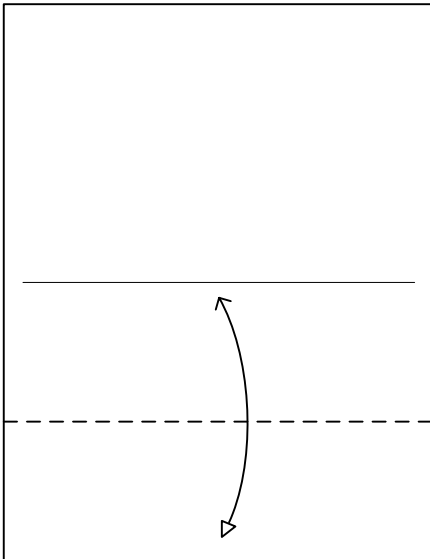


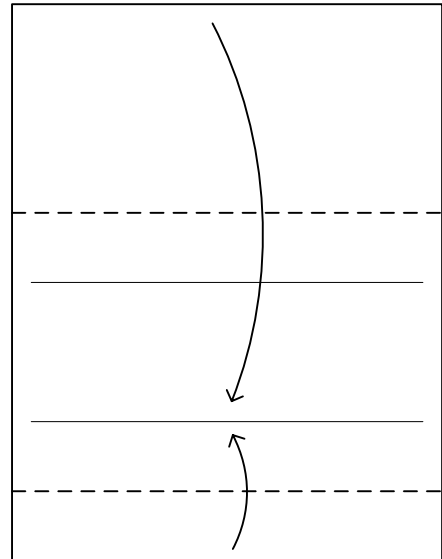
Masked Super Hero



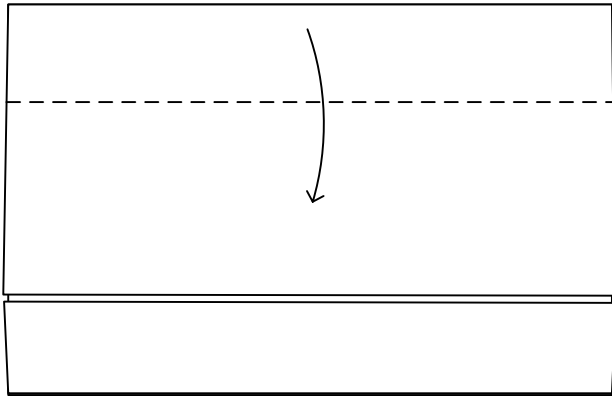
1. Valley-fold and unfold the top edge to the bottom.



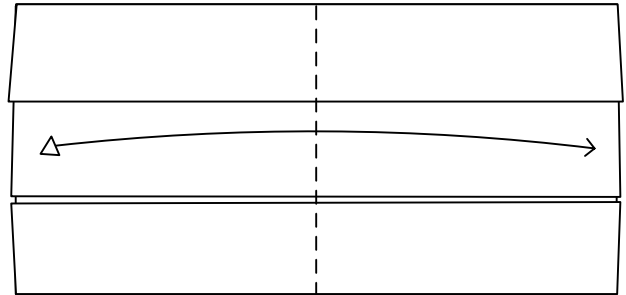
2. Valley-fold and unfold the bottom edge to the center.



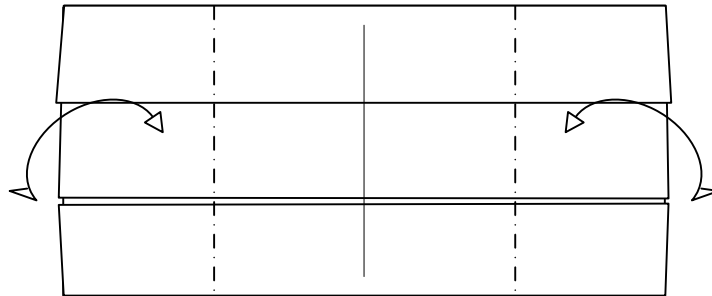
3. Valley-fold the top and bottom edges to the crease you made in step 2.



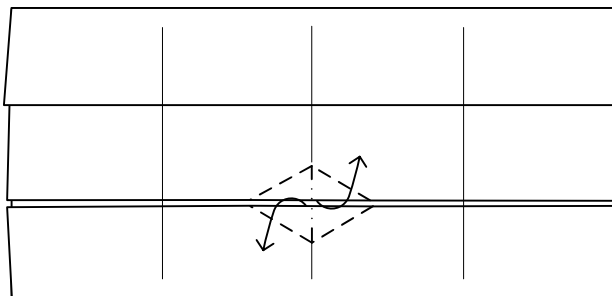
4. Valley-fold the model over along the existing crease from the rear flap. The dotted line indicates the location of this crease.



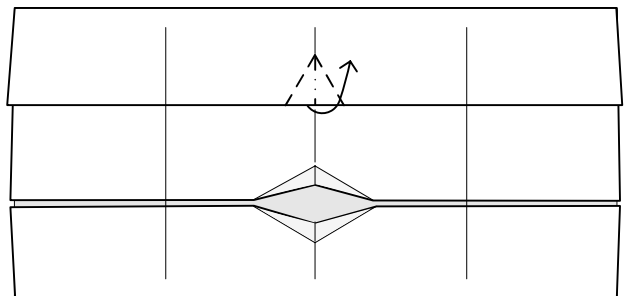
5. Valley-fold and unfold the left edge to the right.



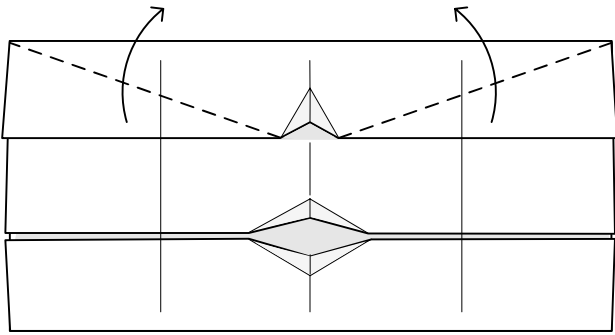
6. Mountain-fold and unfold the left and right edges to the center crease (made in step 5).



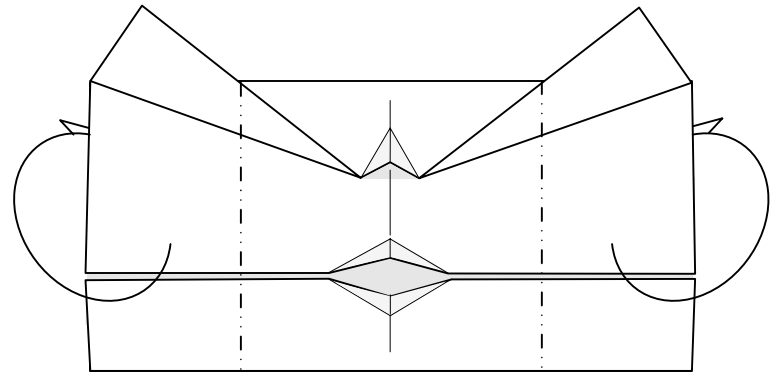
7. Form the mouth by lifting and creasing the flaps top and bottom as shown here. The placement of the creases is up to you; for a bigger mouth, lift further before creasing.



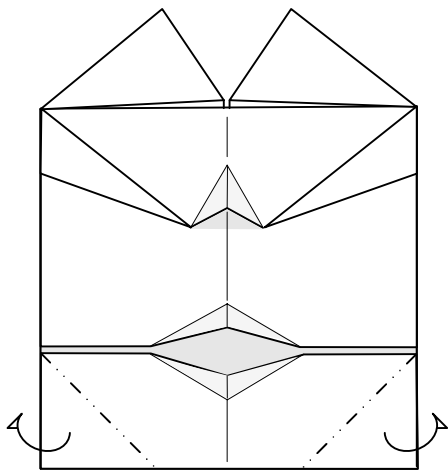
8. Form the nose by lifting and creasing the edge above the mouth. You can make the nose as big or as small as you want.



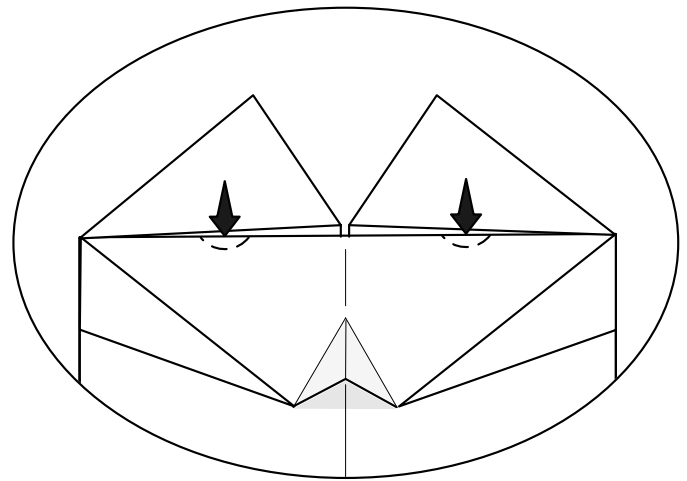
9. Valley-fold the lower corners of the top edge up, connecting the upper left and right corners with the points on the left and right base of the nose.



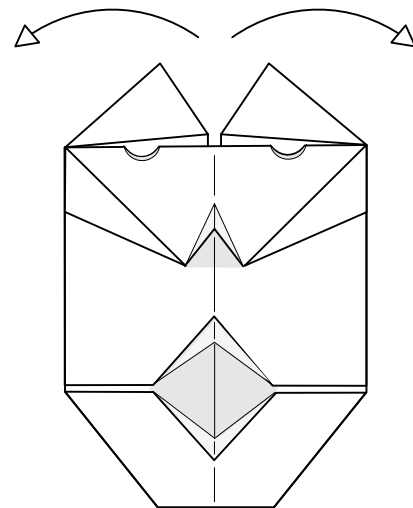
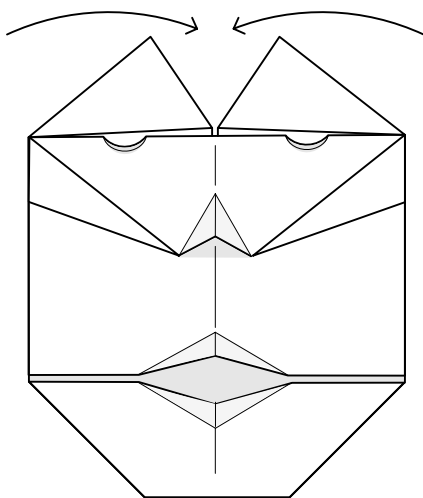
10. Mountain-fold the right and left sides behind along existing creases.



11. Shape the face by mountain-folding the lower left and right corners behind.



12. Create impressions of eyes by pushing downward into the horizontal edge near the top. Make these indentations only on the near edge.



Here is the result. To make the model talk, open and close it like a book.
